Guidelines for Use

© 2020 AILA. This logo signifies membership status in the Association for the year noted and is not an official endorsement of an individual attorney.

The American Immigration Lawyers Association (AILA) will provide the 2020 logo to any active-approved member in good standing. The logo may be used to indicate that **an individual attorney** is a member of AILA. This can be via an attorney bio on a firm website, individual attorney business cards, classified advertisements that list the name of an individual attorney, or other like print/electronic promotions.

- If, for any reason, an individual's membership should lapse or be canceled, the logo must immediately be removed from any written, printed or electronic materials maintained, displayed or distributed.
- The AILA member logo can not be modified, manipulated or changed in any way from its original design, nor can it be used as a feature or design element of any other logo (e.g., a law firm logo).
- The AILA member logo can not be used to imply an endorsement by AILA of any law firm or practice group.
- AILA membership is open only to individual attorneys, not to law firms. Therefore, use of the logo cannot imply membership in AILA by a firm, only by an individual attorney.
- The AILA member logo will only be given to active-approved AILA members who have passed their 90-day application review period.

I agree to abide by these guidelines for the use of the AILA member logo. I understand that AILA reserves the right to monitor the use of the logo at all times and may request a member who is in violation of these usage guidelines to remove the logo immediately and at the member's expense.
