HIGH SCHOOL USA

High School USA is a cultural exchange program that gives international exchange students the opportunity to come to the U.S. for five or ten months to live, study, and immerse themselves in American culture. While here, students attend an American high school, live with a caring host family, practice their English, and experience American culture firsthand.

CAMP EXCHANGE USA

Summer camp is a unique opportunity for youth workers, university students, and teachers to immerse themselves in American culture through the time-honored tradition of camp. As counselors, participants will have an amazing summer mentoring children, building new skills, and making life-long friends from all over the world.

While internships may be paid or unpaid, most CIEE participants select paid positions.
